



## General Information – Spring and Summer 2024

*For children ages 8 through 16*

Thank you for choosing Discover Archery Camp! We're excited to have your child join us in making lasting memories while learning about the sport of archery. Please read all information below and be sure you have updated contact information before the start of your camp.

### Check In / Check Out

- Authorized parents and guardians will check campers in/out with a coach inside the archery range.
- Authorized parents and guardians can be added during registration. Please contact us if any changes are necessary.
- Authorized parents and guardians must bring a photo ID for Check Out.
- Drop off begins 30 minutes prior to the start of camp.
- All campers must be picked up no later than 5:30 PM to avoid late charges.

### Camp Rules

- Toys, games, cell phones, and any other outside items may be used during specified times, as designated by a coach. We reserve the right to restrict use of anything deemed dangerous or disruptive on the range.
- Easton Newberry Archery Center is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
- Safety is our number one priority! Campers are expected to follow range safety rules and all coach instructions. Parents are responsible for reviewing our [Archery Safety Rules and Code of Conduct](#) prior to the start of camp. Coaches will review all rules with students on their first day of camp.
- Our aim is to maintain a welcoming, inclusive, and fun environment for all campers. In the case of disciplinary issues, we approach each situation individually, and will keep parents informed of any challenges their child may face.
- Serious disciplinary infractions may necessitate immediate action, including being excluded from activities, going home early, or removal from camp. If a child is deemed unsafe to themselves or those around them, parents will be required to pick their child up early. Our goal is to ensure the well-being, happiness, and safety of all campers.

### Camp Attire

- ALL campers must wear closed-toed tennis shoes daily. No slides, jellies, flip-flops, or Crocs are allowed. **Campers will not be allowed to shoot without closed-toed shoes.**
- Athletic attire or snug-fitting clothing is highly recommended. Long hair should be tied back. No dangling jewelry.
- A camp T-shirt is included with registration. T-shirts will be handed out on the last day of camp.

### Snacks / Lunches / Water

- Campers are expected to bring lunch from home each day. Please send your camper with an insulated lunch box or bag lunch. The use of microwaves or refrigerators is not available.
- A selection of healthy snacks is included in your camper's registration. Please let us know if your child has any dietary restrictions and we will try to accommodate them. Half day campers will have 1 snack break a day. Full-day campers will have 2 snack breaks a day. Parents are welcome to pack additional snacks in their child's lunch box if needed.
- Additional concessions and drinks may be purchased at our front desk at designated snack and lunch breaks. Parents may prepurchase items in the morning.
- **Campers will need to bring a refillable water bottle every day.** It is preferable that the water bottle be labelled with the camper's name. Disposable cups will be provided for campers who forget to bring one.
